

Medium of Instruction and Examinations

As per provisions under the Maulana Azad National Urdu University Act 1996, the Medium of Instruction is Urdu. As per the Academic Ordinance (3) framed under the University Act and notified in the Gazette of India vide notification MANUU/Admin.I/F.I/2006-07/716 dated 7th April 2005

"Question papers for all Examinations shall be set and answered in the Urdu Language subject to the condition that question papers for all examinations in the languages shall be set and answered in the respective languages."

In the light of above Ordinance, and Statutory provisions, it is hereby reiterated that all the question papers shall be in Urdu and the students shall write the answer in Urdu, except for languages like Arabic, English, Hindi and Persian. If a student fails to write answers in Urdu, no marks shall be awarded to him/her.

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1. University Profile

Maulana Azad National Urdu University (MANUU) is a Central University, established by an Act of Parliament in 1998 with all India jurisdiction. The headquarters and main campus of MANUU is in Gachibowli, Hyderabad. It is spread over 200 acres. MANUU is recognized as a major higher education service provider across the remote areas of the country in Urdu Medium through its regular and distance mode programmes. MANUU commenced with distance education programmes in 1998 and consolidated its regular academic and research programmes in 2004.

The University is named after Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, a scholar par excellence, a prolific writer, an inimitable orator, a gallant freedom fighter, a visionary of the post independent Indian education system and an architect of technical and scientific education in Independent India.

Presently, MANUU is in the process of consolidating the existing institutions, while expanding it to reach the unreached through various intervention measures. Further, to meet the rising aspirations of its youth in general and Urdu speaking community in specific, the University is making considerable progress in all fronts of academics, research and governance with specific vision, mission and objectives.

1.1 Vision

To provide access to quality education through Urdu as medium of instruction, while adhering to the inclusive policy.

1.2 Mission

To empower socially, economically, educationally and culturally marginalized sections of the society so that they are brought into the mainstream, and thereby contribute to the socio-economic development of the nation through formal and non-formal modes of educational delivery.

1.3 Mandates & Objectives

The Objectives of the University as per Section 4 of MANUU Act, 1996 (No.2 of 1997) are:

- to promote and develop the Urdu language;
- to impart education and training in vocational and technical subjects through the medium of *Urdu*;
- to provide wider access to people desirous of pursuing programmes of higher education and training in Urdu medium through teaching on the campus as well as through distance mode and
- to provide focus on Women Education.

In order to achieve the objectives, the University endeavors to:

- provide good learning experience to the students through Urdu language with due emphasis on interactive and innovative teaching-learning as well as engagement in social outreach
- adhere to global best practices and benchmark in respect of academic and research outcomes and also outreach initiatives
- increase the student capacity to meet the growing demands of competent manpower in national and international markets
- augment the internal revenue/receipts through continuing education, sponsored research and consultancy
- improve the quality of life of impoverished millions by producing competent manpower who can contribute for the growth of National economy
- utilize the resources effectively and optimally and also to transform the University into a smart, digital and clean campus with specific action driven initiatives



2.0 School of Education and Training

The School of Education & Training was established in 2006. The objective of School of Education and Training is to prepare a community of excellent school teachers and teacher educators rooted in tradition and well-equipped for future. The emphasis of the school is on the functional relationship between knowledge generation, theory development and effective practice through Urdu medium. The School of Education & Training is well equipped in terms of faculty and infrastructure. MANUU has focused on preparing teachers for Urdu medium schools since its inception. The first batch of D.Ed. Programme was started in 2001 followed by the establishment of the Department of Education and Training in 2004 with the addition of B.Ed. Programme in the same year.

Taking inspiration from and in accordance with the directives of NEP 2020, MANUU adopted and launched the Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the 2023-24 batch as part of its implementation efforts. In the academic year 2023-24, the Department of Education and Training at MANUU, Hyderabad campus, received permission from NCTE to offer the ITEP programme (Secondary) under Humanities, Commerce, and Sciences. This includes the 4-year integrated B.A. B.Ed., 4-year integrated B.Com. B.Ed., and 4-year integrated B.Sc. B.Ed. programs.

MANUU is in the process of expansion and has applied to NCTE for recognition to start ITEP Programme from 2025-26 at CTE, Bhopal (Madhya Pradesh) (ITEP- B.A.B.Ed-Preparatory-1 Unit), CTE, Darbhanga (Bihar) (ITEP- B.A.B.Ed-Preparatory-1 Unit), CTE, Srinagar (Jammu and Kashmir) (ITEP- B.A.B.Ed-Middle-1 Unit) and at MANUU Varanasi Campus (Uttar Pradesh)((ITEP- B.A.B.Ed-Middle-1 Unit) and will be offering it only subject to recognition orders received from NCTE.

2.1 Department of Education and Training

The School has a Department of Education and Training at the University Campus at Hyderabad that imparts quality education in modern pattern through Urdu medium at different levels of teacher education from Diploma (D.El.Ed), Under Graduate (B.Ed.), Post-Graduate (M.Ed.) to Research level (Ph.D.) programmes. The Department of Education and Training, MANUU Hyderabad campus is one of the institutions granted permission by NCTE to run the ITEP programme (secondary) under Humanities, Commerce and Sciences i.e., 4-year integrated B.A.B.Ed., 4-year integrated B.Com.B.Ed. and 4-year integrated B.Sc.B.Ed with secondary stage specialization for teaching Grades 9 to Grade 12.

2.2 Constituent Colleges of Teacher Education

The School has a network of eight constituent Colleges of Teacher Education spread across the country. The School through its eight constituent Colleges of Teacher Education offers B.Ed. Programme located at Srinagar (J&K), Darbhanga (Bihar), Bhopal (MP), Sambhal (UP), Asansol (WB), Aurangabad (MS), Bidar (Karnataka) and Nuh (Haryana). Further, M.Ed. and Ph.D. programmes are also offered at two Colleges of Teacher Education located at Darbhanga (Bihar) and Bhopal (MP).

CTE-Srinagar is a constituent college of MANUU-Hyderabad, established in the year 2005. In the year 2012 M.Ed. (Regular) course was started.

College of Teacher Education, Bhopal, a constituent college of MANUU, Hyderabad, was established in 2007, to meet the demand for Urdu-medium teachers. It has grown into a leading teacher education institution, introducing M.Ed. in 2014 and Ph.D. in Education in 2017.

College of Teacher Education, Darbhanga (Bihar), a constituent college of MANUU, Hyderabad, was established in 2007, is located at Ilyasashraf Nagar, Chandanpatti Village, Darbhanga. it aims to meet the growing demand for Urdu-medium teachers in Bihar and beyond. The college introduced M.Ed. in 2014 and Ph.D. in Education in 2018, further strengthening its academic programs.

MANUU Varanasi campus began operations as a separate campus in Varanasi (Uttar Pradesh), supporting MANUU's mission to promote Urdu-medium education and teacher training across India. In 2024, it launched the 4YUG program as part of the NEP-2020 implementation.

2.3 Integrated Teacher Education Programme

The 4-year integrated B.Ed. will be a dual-major holistic bachelor's degree, in Education as well as a specialized subject (such as language, history, music, mathematics, computer science, chemistry, economics, art, physical-education, etc). Beyond the teaching of cutting-edge pedagogy, the teacher education will include a grounding in sociology, history, science, psychology, early childhood care, and education, foundational literacy and numeracy, knowledge of India and its values/ethos/art/traditions, and more. [NEP 2020: 15.5]



The ITEP is a Dual Major Programme -the first major is in Education with School Specific Stage specialization and the second major is in an opted discipline. The approach to the design and implementation of ITEP are:

- Education in Multidisciplinary Environment
- 4 Year duration after grade 12 of the school system
- Admission through National Common Entrance Test (NCET) conducted by NTA
- Minimal degree qualification to become a teacher by 2030
- Responsive to new 5+3+3+4 design
- Introduction of Credit System as per UGC
- Integrated Dual-Major Degree- Disciplinary & Professional Knowledge of Education
- Focus on 21st Century Skills
- Stage Specialization (5+3+3+4): Each student will specialize in one of the following school stages which will qualify them to become teachers of that Stage:
 - i. Foundational Stage Specialization (for teaching Pre-School to Grade 2)
 - ii. Preparatory Stage Specialization (for teaching Grades 3 to Grade 5)
 - iii. Middle Stage Specialization (for teaching Grades 6 to Grade 8)
 - iv. Secondary Stage Specialization (for teaching Grades 9 to Grade 12)

3.0 Criteria for Admissions

3.1 General Eligibility Conditions

- i. The candidates are required to compulsorily go through the NTA information bulletin and MANUU ITEP Prospectus before filling up their online application forms for their admission.
- ii. For admission in University programmes,
 - a. Urdu as a subject/language or as a Medium in 10th/12th/Graduation level or equivalent Madrasa courses with Urdu as medium of Instruction approved by MANUU. (For Proof of Urdu)
 - b. Candidates with minimum fifty percent marks in Senior Secondary or plus two (+2) examination or its equivalent (under 5+3+3+4 pattern) from a recognized board are eligible for admission.
- iii. Relaxation as per GOI norms.
- iv. Candidates studied from State Madrasa Education board are also eligible to apply for the ITEP programme.

3.2 Age limit for Admissions

3.3 Details of National Common Entrance Test (NCET)

The National Testing Agency has been entrusted with the responsibility of conducting the National Common Entrance Test (NCET) and inviting Online Applications of the National Common Entrance Test (NCET) for admission to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) in selected Central/State University/Institutions including IITs, NITs, RIEs, and Government Colleges for the Academic Session 2025-26.

Admission Procedure for MANUU:

- 1. Admission in ITEP shall be through the score obtained in National Common Entrance Test (NCET) conducted by NTA.
- 2. At the time of application to the programme, the candidate must indicate the subjects/discipline (B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed./B.Com. B.Ed.)

4.0 Reservation and Relaxation Provisions

The University follows the reservation policies of the Government of India issued from time to time. The reservations are applicable to all programmes. There are two kinds of reservations (Vertical and Horizontal) adopted by the University to accommodate adequate representation of various categories of students as an inclusive policy. The applicants claiming any of these categories need to submit the valid proof of the caste/ tribe/ other reservation in the prescribed form issued by the competent authorities as per the Government of India norms at the time of admission, failing which applicant shall not be considered for admission.
