Eligibility:

- Candidate should be a permanent/regular full-time employee with minimum of three years experience.
- Candidates seeking admission to the Ph.D. programs shall have a Master's degree in the concerned subject or an allied subject or in area of specialization with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale in case of grading system.
